3. Natural hazards such as surface or subsurface conditions; or
4. Collisions with other livestock or objects.

I acknowledge being notified, pursuant to South Dakota Statute 42, 11 subd. 2 "an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities".

I accept responsibility for the inherent risks involved in livestock activities, including the likelihood of serious injury and death. I have read this release and understand all of its terms and accept this as adequate notice, pursuant to SD S. 42.11.subd 2. I voluntarily sign this release with full knowledge that I will not be able to commence an action or suit in any forum against or hold the Committee, the City or Sutton Rodeos liable for such injuries.
